

# 2025–2026 Tuition Information

*A cleaner, consolidated guide to tuition rates, discounts, payment options, and related student costs.*

Prepared from the tuition information currently published on the MorningStar University website.

## Early Payment Discount

Students who pay in full by August 1 receive a 10% discount on the base tuition rate.

## Important Note

Discounts do not apply to the “major” portion of tuition.

## Flexible Payment

Payment plans are available upon request through the MSU office.

## General Information

MorningStar University offers tuition structures for first-year students, second-year associate’s students, and third-year bachelor’s students. In the first year, students may either enroll in the core classes track without a major fee or choose one of MSU’s majors—School of Worship, School of Ministry, Company of the Prophets, School of Communications, or Special Forces—which includes the core classes plus the major fee. Credits earned may vary depending on course load, practicum, and individual academic choices. Students should consult an academic advisor when planning their path toward graduation.

## First-Year Tuition

Applies to the first-year options currently offered by MorningStar University.

First-Year Major Track (School of Worship, School of Ministry, Company of the Prophets, School of Communications, or Special Forces)	\$5,950 + \$1,950 major	48	Core classes and major coursework

## Second-Year Tuition (Associate's)

The website states that the information below applies to all five majors at MorningStar University.

Program Track	Tuition Cost	Credits	What's Included
Year Two Tuition	\$4,250 + \$1,950 major (\$6,200 total)	40	Core classes, electives, and major coursework
Wilderness Trips	Included	—	Special Forces students only

International trips are generally not covered by tuition, with the exception of some select deployments in crisis situations.

^ Credits may vary depending on individual student choices for course load and practicum. Students should consult an academic advisor to confirm their chosen path.

## Third-Year Tuition (Bachelor's)

The website states that the information below applies to all five majors at MorningStar University.

Year Three Tuition	\$3,750 + \$1,950 major (\$5,700 total)	Varies by major	Core classes, electives, and major-specific practicum/coursework
Wilderness Trips	Included	—	Special Forces students only

International trips are generally not covered by tuition, with the exception of some select deployments in crisis situations.

^ Credits earned in the third year may vary according to course load and practicum requirements specific to each major. Students should consult an academic advisor to confirm graduation requirements during registration.

## **Other Costs and Benefits**

### **Campus Housing**

Campus housing is currently around \$500 per month and is subject to change and availability. Tuition does not include housing. Students may be placed in bunkhouses or the MorningStar hotel depending on availability. Select students may enroll in work-study to help cover housing costs. For the most current housing information, students should confirm rates and availability through the MSU Office and the Housing and Student Life information channel.

### **Exclusive MorningStar Events**

All MorningStar conferences are free to MSU students during the school year, and significant discounts are offered for non-MorningStar conferences held at the H.I.M. facilities. Free conferences for students include the Harvest Fest Conference, the Advanced Prophetic Conference, the New Year’s Conference, and more.

### **Company of the Prophets Intensive Note**

The School of the Prophets Intensive is included only for students enrolled in the Company of the Prophets major track. Other students may enroll in the intensive weekend for a discounted registration fee and receive additional course credits.

### **Outreaches, Missions Trips, and Crisis Deployments**

During the school year, MSU plans strategic outreaches within the United States, missions trips, and crisis deployments as circumstances dictate. Some outreach travel expenses may be covered by partner churches, ministries, or school fundraising, while other outreaches may require student

contribution. Traditional missions trips are generally paid for by students and are not typically covered by tuition or outside support. Crisis deployments are often covered by donors who support the crisis response plan, but some require additional training and may be limited to students in the Special Forces program.
